VOLUNTEERS AND INTERNS

Since February we are in the good company of interns: three interns Kindergarten of Thomas More University and two interns Applied Psychology of HoWest University.


The intern-teachers teach their own class every day. The children who attend their class change daily or weekly. They work on different themes, in consultation with the teacher. The children learned a lot already about different animals, shapes, colours and so much more!

The interns Applied Psychology work in different areas. They work individually with some students who need more guidance. They give counselling, work on concentration problems, how to deal with problems at home, etc.

Next to that they also work with a group of students from secondary schools about their future vision: what do I like to do, what are my talents, what would I like to do after school, etc. This can help the students in building their future vision and can motivate them to work hard for this and study hard. The students like it a lot and it's also very interesting for us.

Next to the interns we have one more volunteer who started right before the Easter holiday. She will work in different areas in the school and for iThemba.
